

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF PRINCETON REGULATING SNOW
AND ICE REMOVAL ON SIDEWALKS
AND BICYCLE PATHS, AND
AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW
JERSEY, 1968".**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:

1. Sec. 19-2 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which regulates the removal of snow and ice on sidewalks and bicycle paths is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 19-2. Snow and ice on sidewalks and bicycle paths to be removed or covered by owner or occupant of bordering premises.

The owner or occupant of premises abutting or bordering on sidewalks and bicycle paths along public streets in the Township shall remove or cause to be removed from the sidewalks and bicycle paths in front of or bordering upon their premises all snow and ice within forty-eight hours after such snow shall have ceased falling thereon or after such ice shall have formed thereon. In the case of ice that may be so frozen as to make removal impracticable, the owner or occupant shall cause the same to be thoroughly covered with sand or other suitable material, within forty-eight (48) hours after such ice shall have formed thereon.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of Princeton Township Committee held on May 10, 2010 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held at the Princeton Township Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street on May 24, 2010 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
