Proposed Clinical Fee Schedule Effective Date: January 1, 2023

Suggested Motion for the Corner House Board: That Corner House set a clinical fee structure as follows, effective January 1, 2023:

Service	Current Fee	Proposed Fee	Medicaid Rate (for comparison) State-funded rates are 10% less
Comprehensive Substance Abuse Evaluation (intake appointment and followup session)	\$220	\$250	\$180.75
Individual Session (38 - 55 minutes)	\$110	\$125	\$99.29
Individual Session (20 - 37 minutes)	Not specified	\$85	\$75.03
Family Therapy Session, with or without patient	\$110	\$150	\$113.94
Group Session	\$55	\$55	\$28.88
Intensive Outpatient Services (per day)	\$220	\$220	\$114.95
Psychiatric Evaluation	\$325	\$400	\$460.08_
Medication Management Checkup	\$110	\$125	\$85.00 - \$124.10
Penalty for non-attendance or late cancellation (< 24 hours' notice)	--	\$35	not allowed

Rationale: Corner House has not adjusted its rates since 2016. The proposed fee structure:

- is based on the 45-minute individual session.
- assesses the initial evaluation and followup appointment at the price of 2 individual sessions.
- is comparable to current New Jersey Medicaid rates.
- is less expensive than most Princeton-area providers, allowing Corner House to increase revenue while continuing its commitment to the Princeton community.



Proposed Sliding Scale Fee Structure

Suggested Motion for the Corner House Board: That Corner House set a sliding-scale fee structure as follows, effective January 1, 2023:

Federal Poverty Level	Individual, Family	Group = 1/2 individual	Med Check = Individual	Evaluation (Intake) = 2x Individual	Drug Screen
Below 350%	\$35	\$18	\$35	\$70	at cost
351 - 400%	\$47	\$24	\$47	\$93	at cost
401 - 450%	\$58	\$29	\$58	\$117	at cost
451 - 500%	\$70	\$35	\$70	\$140	at cost
501 - 550%	\$95	\$48	\$95	\$190	at cost
551 - 600%	\$120	\$60	\$120	\$240	at cost
over 600% is full-fee	\$125	\$63	\$125	\$250	at cost

Rationale: The proposed minimum (\$35) approximates the actual hourly cost of a clinician. Increments are based on Federal Poverty Level (FPL), the same reference used to determine New Jersey Family Care and Medicaid eligibility and rates.

Drug screen fees, which are billed at cost, are shown below for reference:
