RESOLUTION 19-244

Resolution Authorizing a Professional Services Agreement in the Not to Exceed Amount of \$53,300.00 with IH Engineers, PC for the Design and Permitting of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon Installations at US Route 206 / Herrontown Road, Bunn Drive / Karl Light Boulevard (southern leg) and Jefferson Road / Guyot Avenue Bike Path

WHEREAS, the municipality of Princeton desires to retain the services of a professional transportation engineer for purposes of designing and permitting rectangular rapid flashing beacon installations on behalf of Princeton; and

WHEREAS, IH Engineers, PC has provided a proposal to Princeton for purposes of performing the sought-after transportation engineering design services for the not to exceed contract amount of \$53,300.00 and term of one year; and

WHEREAS, Princeton has a need to acquire these services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law” and in connection therewith, IH Engineers, PC has completed and filed with Princeton the required Campaign Contributions Affidavit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.8, Certification Regarding Political Contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26 and affidavit pursuant section 2-87 of the Princeton Code (collectively, the “Pay-to-Play Forms”); and

WHEREAS, the agreement shall be for an amount not to exceed \$53,300.00, as more specifically detailed in IH Engineers’ proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available in capital account #04-215-15-007-076-355 and an off-tract contribution from 775 State Road in account #21-285-20-061-001 to pay for said services; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(I)*, authorizes Princeton to award this agreement as a professional services agreement, without public bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with IH Engineers, PC for designing and permitting rectangular rapid flashing beacon installations, consistent with this Resolution and the above "Whereas" clauses.
2. The agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as a professional services agreement as authorized under *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(I)*.
3. IH Engineers, PC shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$53,300.00. The term of the agreement shall be one year.
4. A copy of this Resolution, the Pay-to-Play Forms and the agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
5. A notice of this action shall be published in the official newspaper as required by law.
