**RESOLUTION 19-277**

**Resolution Authorizing Execution of Agreement With Curb My Clutter, LLC for Recycle Material Pilot Program**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Princeton (“Princeton”) has determined it to be in the public interest to optimize the collection from its residents, and processing by Princeton, of certain recyclable materials to keep them out of the solid waste disposal stream; and

**WHEREAS**, Curb My Clutter LLC (“CMC”) is a SaaS provider that assists municipalities optimize the collection from residents, and processing by such municipalities, of certain recyclable materials, and specifically textiles and electronics; and

**WHEREAS**, Princeton and CMC seek to enter into an Agreement for purpose of establishing a Pilot Program for a term of one year that would assist Princeton optimize and monetize the collection and recycling of certain electronics and textiles; and

**WHEREAS**, CMC will be responsible for collecting the specified recyclable materials from residents, and CMC will share in the profit received from the sale to third parties of the recyclable materials by paying 10% of such profits to Princeton; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Attorney’s Office has opined that the proposed Agreement may be procured and executed as a concession pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.4; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the aggregate value of the Agreement with CMC for a one year term will not likely exceed the bid threshold of \$40,000; and

**WHEREAS**, because the aggregate value of the Agreement, including any fees paid by residents and the profits from the sale of recyclable materials, will not likely exceed \$40,000, the applicable rules allow Princeton to procure the Agreement through informal quotations; and


**WHEREAS**, the only estimated costs to Princeton as part of this agreement include general oversight and enforcement of the Agreement and Princeton’s use of CMC’s digital platform and software for purposes of scheduling collections.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Princeton Council on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2019 that:

1. The foregoing “Whereas Clauses” are incorporated herein as if set forth at length.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Pilot Program Agreement with Curb My Clutter LLC. The final form of the Agreement shall be subject to the Municipal Attorney’s prior approval.
3. A copy of this Resolution and Agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.
