



RESOLUTION 19-365

Resolution Authorizing a Supplemental Professional Services Agreement with Storm Water Management Consulting, LLC (SWM Consulting) in the Not to Exceed Amount of \$15,000.00 (Total Not to Exceed Amended Contract Amount of \$30,000) for Storm Water Management Development Application Review Services for 2019

WHEREAS, by Resolution #19-11 adopted on January 3, 2019, the Municipality of Princeton (“Princeton”) entered into a Professional Services Agreement (“PSA”) with Storm Water Management Consulting, LLC (“SWM Consulting”) for the not to exceed amount of \$15,000.00; and

WHEREAS, based on Princeton’s needs, the Princeton Engineering Department recommends increasing the contract amount by \$15,000.00 for a total not to exceed contract amount of \$30,000.00 to complete the required professional services through the end of 2019; and

WHEREAS, Princeton continues to have a need to acquire these services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law” and in connection therewith, SWM Consulting has completed and filed with Princeton the required Campaign Contributions Affidavit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.8, Certification Regarding Political Contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26 and affidavit pursuant section 2-87 of the Princeton Code; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available in the appropriate development escrow account to pay for said increased cost for SWM Consulting’s services; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, *N.J.A.C. 5:30-11.6*, authorizes Princeton to amend the PSA by increasing the not to exceed amount.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Princeton Mayor and Council, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The PSA with SWM Consulting for storm water management consultant services for development applications on behalf of Princeton’s land use boards, is hereby amended to increase the not to exceed contract amount to \$30,000.00, consistent with the above “Whereas” clauses.
2. Princeton shall pay SWM Consulting in accordance with the 2019 SWM Consulting Fee Schedule for the work hours completed. The term of the PSA shall end on December 31, 2019. All remaining provisions of the PSA not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.
3. This Resolution, when countersigned by SWM Consulting, shall serve as an amendment to the original PSA, for the purpose of confirming the increased not to exceed amount of \$30,000.00.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed on file in the Clerk’s Office and shall be available for public inspection.
