



RESOLUTION 19-378

Resolution Authorizing a Professional Services Agreement with WSP USA Inc. for a Traffic Engineering Study of Up to Eleven Intersections in the Vicinity of US Route 206, Valley Road, Ewing Street, and North Harrison Street for a Cost Not to Exceed \$79,409.69

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Princeton retained the services of a professional traffic engineering firm for purposes of completing a corridor assessment of US Route 206 in relation to the closure of Terhune Road for the Princeton First Aid and Rescue Headquarters (PFARS) development; and

WHEREAS, Princeton Council authorized a contract with WSP USA via Resolution 19-40 to provide the sought-after concept development and transportation engineering and planning services at a not to exceed contract amount of \$69,858.50 and term of one year; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation completed traffic improvements at US Route 206 and Cherry Hill Road based upon recommendations from said services; and

WHEREAS, new bicycle, pedestrian, and vehicular traffic counts and traffic analyses are required at the five intersections surrounding the PFARS headquarter to measure the effect of the built improvements and to identify additional traffic improvements needed for safe movement through these roadways; and

WHEREAS, Princeton seeks additional bicycle, pedestrian, and vehicular data and traffic analyses at up to six additional intersections on Valley Road, Terhune Road, North Harrison Street, and US Route 206 to identify whether warrants exist for intersection improvements at these locations; and

WHEREAS, Princeton has a need to acquire these services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law” and

WHEREAS, the agreement shall be for an amount not to exceed \$79,409.69, as more specifically detailed in WSP USA’s proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services from capital accounts 04-215-15-007-076-350 (\$6,777.00), 04-215-15-007-076-340 (\$20,000.00), 04-215-18-007-076-326 (\$5,235.79), and 04-215-19-021-076-348 (\$47,396.90); and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(I), authorizes Princeton to award this agreement as a professional services agreement, without public bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with WSP USA for \$79,409.69, consistent with this Resolution and the above “Whereas” clauses.
2. The agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as a professional services agreement as authorized under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(I).
3. WSP USA shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$79,409.69. The term of the agreement shall be one year.
4. A copy of this Resolution, the Pay-to-Play Forms and the agreement shall be

placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.

5. A notice of this action shall be published in the official newspaper as required by law.
