



RESOLUTION 20-59

Resolution Authorizing a Contract Award to Remington Vernick Engineers (RVE) in the Amount Not To Exceed \$129,025.64 for Construction Management / Construction Inspection Services for the Federally-Funded Harrison Street Signals Project

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Princeton desires to obtain professional construction management and construction inspection services for the federally-funded project entitled “Pedestrian Upgrades to Two Harrison Street Traffic Signals (Federal Project No.: TAP-2239(300)); and

WHEREAS, Princeton advertised for and solicited proposals through in accordance with the requirements of 49 CFR Part 18 and Federal Brooks Act; and

WHEREAS, in connection therewith, Princeton received proposals on Tuesday, October 8, 2019 from the following nine (9) consultants:

1. French & Parrello Associates, Wall, New Jersey;
2. Greenman-Pedersen, Inc., Lebanon, New Jersey;
3. Johnson, Mirmiran & Thompson, Inc., Trenton, New Jersey;
4. KS Engineer, P.C., Mount Laurel, New Jersey;

6. Pennoni Associates, Newark, New Jersey;
7. T & M Associates, Mount Laurel, New Jersey;
8. Urban Engineers Inc., Cherry Hill, New Jersey;
9. Remington & Vernick Engineers, Inc., Cherry Hill, New Jersey;

to undertake and complete said services; and

WHEREAS, a selection committee comprised of two Princeton employees and one Mercer County employee reviewed and rated the qualifications of the consultants based on the

criteria published in the Request for Proposals; and

WHEREAS, Remington & Vernick Engineers, Inc. (RVE), of Cherry Hill, New Jersey received the highest ratings based on their qualifications for the project scope; and

WHEREAS, RVE's cost proposal of \$129,025.64 was reviewed and found to be acceptable; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation advised in an email on December 13, 2019 that additional federal funds will be allocated to the Municipality of Princeton's project to cover the cost of these construction management / construction inspection services on a reimbursable basis; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available in capital accounts 04-215-19-021-076-352 and 04-215-15-007-076-340 to pay for said services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Remington & Vernick Engineers, Inc. for professional construction management and construction inspection services, consistent with this Resolution and the above "Whereas" clauses.
2. Remington & Vernick Engineers, Inc. shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$129,025.64.

3. The term of the contract shall be one year.
4. A copy of this Resolution and the agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
5. A notice of this action shall be published in the official newspaper as required by
