



RESOLUTION 20-85

Resolution Approving the Placement Pole Banners on Nassau Street
by the Arts Council on Monday, April 13, 2020 to Monday, April 27,
2020

WHEREAS, The Arts Council of Princeton is planning Communiversy for Sunday, April 26,
2020; and

WHEREAS, The Arts Council of Princeton has requested permission to install eight pole
banners on Nassau Street with the approval of the Office of Community and State Affairs at
Princeton University beginning April 13, 2020 through April 27, 2020 to advertise
Communiversy; and

WHEREAS, the pole banners will be promptly removed after use as required by Borough
ordinances; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Borough Ordinance 3-17 any banner that is removed by
Princeton will be held by Princeton for thirty (30) days and then disposed of; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Borough Ordinance 3-17 any applicant failing to remove a
banner will not be permitted to display any banner for the succeeding two years; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council hereby approve
placement of said pole banners on Nassau Street in accordance with Borough Ordinances 3-14-3-
17.
