



**RESOLUTION 20-138**

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**Resolution Authorizing a Bid Award to Traffic Lines, Inc. of Farmingdale, New Jersey in the Not to Exceed Amount of \$71,845.80 for Traffic Striping and Pavement Markings Contract**

**WHEREAS**, Princeton has advertised for and received bids in accordance with the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2 et seq.* for Traffic Striping and Pavement Marking Contract; and

**WHEREAS**, in connection therewith Princeton has received the following four (4) bids on March 12, 2020:

1. \$71,845.80 by Traffic Lines, Inc. of Farmingdale, New Jersey;
2. \$79,262.50 by Straight Edge Striping of Middlesex, New Jersey;
3. \$93,797.50 by Dan Swayze & Son, Inc. of Scotch Plains, New Jersey;
4. \$122,220.00 by Denville Line Painting, Inc. of Rockaway, New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the bid documents provide for an initial contract term for 2020-2021 and up to two (2) additional one-year extensions for 2022 and 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, in reviewing said bids, Princeton has determined that the lowest responsive and responsible bidder is Traffic Lines, Inc. of Farmingdale, New Jersey in the amount of \$71,845.80 based upon the bid price for the initial contract term (2020/2021); and

**WHEREAS**, Princeton has appropriated sufficient funds for this project in capital accounts 04-215-14-025-075-326 (\$10,517.60), 04-25-16-020-075-330 (\$9,482.40), and 04-215-19-021-076-346 (\$51,845.80), as certified by Sandra Webb, Chief Financial Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, Princeton wishes to award a contract to undertake and complete said work to the aforementioned lowest responsible bidder for the initial contract term of 2020-2021, with

the option to extend said term for 2022 and 2023 as set forth in the Contract Documents; and


**WHEREAS**, the continuation of services in 2022 and 2023 shall also be subject to the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds therefor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Princeton Council and the Municipality of Princeton as follows:

1. The Mayor and Municipal Clerk of Princeton are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Traffic Lines, Inc. of Farmingdale, New Jersey for a sum not to exceed \$71,845.80; to undertake and complete the Traffic Striping and Pavement Marking Contract, all in accordance with the terms and conditions with the Bid Documents which are on file in the office of the Clerk.
  
2. A certified true copy of this Resolution shall be furnished upon its adoption to Traffic Lines, Inc., of Farmingdale, New Jersey.
