Resolution Authorizing the Award of a Contract to Ditschman Ford (NJ Parts of Flemington) for the Purchase of Tire Equipment in the amount of \$15,855.00

WHEREAS, the Department of Infrastructure and Operations ("Department") recommends that the Municipality of Princeton ("Princeton") procure new tire equipment; and

WHEREAS, in response to a solicitation for quotes, Princeton received three (3) quotes for said purchase; and

WHEREAS, Ditschman Form (NJ Parts of Flemington) provided the low bid quote to Princeton for purposes of the sought after purchase in the amount of \$15,855.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said purchased in 04-215-19-021-075-336; and

WHEREAS, this contract award is exempt from public bidding pursuant N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3(a) and 40A:11-6.1(a) because the contract amount does not exceed the bid threshold; and

WHEREAS, Princeton wishes to award a contract to undertake and complete said purchase to the aforementioned contractor with the lowest responsible quote.
