



RESOLUTION 20-204

Resolution Authorizing the Award of a Contract to Dyntek Services, Inc. for Infrastructure Upgrade to Police Department Data Network Closet, Amount not to Exceed \$67,784.50

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12 provides that a contracting unit may, without advertising for bids, purchase any materials, supplies or equipment under any contract entered into on behalf of the State by the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of Treasury; and,

WHEREAS, the municipality of Princeton has authorized purchases under the appropriate State Contract, and utilized the bidding advantage done by the State; and,

WHEREAS, Dyntek Services, Inc., 5241 California Ave, Ste. 150, Irvine, CA 92617 has been awarded the New Jersey State Contract #87220, NJ Cisco NVP Contract and;


WHEREAS, the network upgrade contract costs \$67,784.50 for the “Infrastructure Upgrade/Refresh for Police Department” and the appropriate monies are provided in the Capital Balance, Various Improvements, 04-215-16-020-125-387 (\$1,206) and 04-215-18-007-125-346 (\$22,441), 04-215-19-021-125-379 (\$13,000), 04-215-14-025-125-379 (\$10,000), 04-215-15-007-125-381 (\$10,000), and Administrative and Executive Operating and Expenses, 01-201-20-111-283 (11,137.50) and the Chief Financial Officer has certified that the funds are available.
