Resolution Authorizing Agreement with the Marquand Park Foundation for the Restoration of the Structure known as the "ice house" at Marquand Park

WHEREAS, Marquand Park, located on Lovers Lane in Princeton, is owned and operated by PRINCETON.

WHEREAS, the Marquand Park Foundation, a nonprofit corporation of the State of New Jersey, with a business address of P.O. Box 415, Princeton 08542-0415 which supports the maintenance of Marquand Park as an arboretum for purposes of public enjoyment and;

WHEREAS, the Foundation seeks to undertake the restoration of a structure known as the "ice house" at Marquand Park and;

WHEREAS, the Foundation shall donate the labor and materials necessary to restore the ice house at Marquand Park and;


WHEREAS, the scope of work for the Project shall be substantial as set forth in the May 18, 2020 proposal submitted by A. Pennacchi & Son, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Municipality of Princeton, in the County of Mercer, New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement with the Foundation on file with the Municipal Clerk, subject to minor modification or revision as deemed necessary and appropriate by Princeton in consultation with counsel.
2. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and directed, upon the execution of the agreement to attest to the signature of the Mayor upon such document.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
