



RESOLUTION 20-349

Resolution Authorizing The Award Of A Contract To Trap Rock Industries, LLC, PO Box 419, Kingston, New Jersey Via State Contract 18-Fleet-00639 For Road Materials Services (Bituminous Materials - Delivered, Bituminous Cold Weather Hot Patch Materials - FOB, Clean Stone - FOB and Quarry Blend - FOB) For Use By The Municipality Of Princeton In An Amount Not To Exceed \$250,000.00 For The Year 2021

WHEREAS, the Department of Infrastructure and Operations (“Department”) recommends that the Municipality of Princeton (“Princeton”) procure road materials services (bituminous materials - delivered, bituminous cold weather hot patch materials - FOB, clean stone - FOB and quarry blend - FOB) at various location within the Municipality of Princeton for the year 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Department has researched vendors that would achieve the Department’s goals and determined that the sought-after road materials services may be procured from Trap Rock Industries, LLC, PO Box 419, Kingston, New Jersey through New Jersey State Contract 18-Fleet-00639; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3) (as amended by P.L. 2011, c.139) and LFN 2012-10, a New Jersey municipality may purchase goods and services without public bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law through the use of an accepted state contract that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding or contracting process by another contracting unit within New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, also pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3) (as amended by P.L. 2011, c.139) and LFN 2012-10, prior to making purchases under accepted state contract, the municipality must determine that the use of the state contract shall result in cost savings after all factors, including charges for service, material, and delivery, have been considered; and

WHEREAS, consistent with New Jersey State Approved Contract 18-Fleet-00639

Pricing System and needs of Trap Rock Industries, LLC in accordance with the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development Prevailing Wage Rate Determination for road materials services in Mercer County, New Jersey with a contract amount not to exceed \$250,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds in the total amount of \$250,000.00 are available for this purchase as follows:

- Capital Account 04-215-19-021-076-353 in the amount of \$250,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby incorporated as if fully restated.
2. A contract for road materials services for use by the Municipality of Princeton for the not to exceed amount of \$250,000.00 is hereby awarded to Trap Rock Industries, LLC without public bidding as permitted by law.
