



RESOLUTION 20-343

Resolution Authorizing a Professional Services Agreement in an Amount Not to Exceed \$303,140.13 with NV5 for Preliminary Design Services of the Rosedale Road Safe Routes to School Project (\$295,115.12 is Eligible for Reimbursement through Federal Aid Agreement No. 2021-DT-DLA-551 Contract ID: 21 70028)

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Princeton is a recipient of a Fiscal Year 2018 Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 for construction of pedestrian improvements on Rosedale Road (County Route 604) and intersection improvements at General Johnson Road; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) Division of Local Aid has established the SRTS Design Assistance Program, which makes available consultant engineering services to assist recipients of 2018 SRTS grants with the development of plans, specifications, and estimates (PS&E) for their SRTS projects; and

WHEREAS, the Princeton Engineering Department conducted interviews with the three pre-qualified consultants and sought a proposal from NV5 of Parsippany, New Jersey, to develop PS&E for the above-referenced improvements; and

WHEREAS, NV5 submitted a proposal dated March 4, 2020, subsequently revised it based on comments from the Princeton Engineering Department and the New Jersey Department of Transportation, and resubmitted the attached proposal dated July 16, 2020 (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, the NV5 proposal provides scopes of work and fees associated with preliminary design, final design, and construction services in connection with the above-referenced improvements; and

WHEREAS, Princeton has evaluated the proposal in accordance with the requirements

of 49 CFR Part 18 and Federal Brooks Act; and

WHEREAS, Princeton Council has authorized the Mayor and Clerk to execute Federal Aid Agreement No. 2021-DT-DLA-551 Contract ID: 21 70028, which sets forth the terms and conditions of the NJDOT and FHWA's reimbursement funding of these preliminary engineering design services in an amount up to \$295,115.12; and

WHEREAS, at this time, Princeton seeks to hire NV5 to provide preliminary design services for the not to exceed contract amount of \$303,140.13, of which \$295,115.12 is reimbursable through the Federal Aid Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i), authorizes Princeton to award this agreement as a professional services agreement, without public bidding; and


WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available in account 04-215-20-023-076-303 to pay for said services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with NV5 for professional preliminary engineering design services, consistent with this Resolution and the above "Whereas" clauses.
2. NV5 shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$303,140.13.
3. A copy of this Resolution and the agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
4. A notice of this action shall be published in the official newspaper as required by law.
