Resolution Authorizing the Purchase of 5 sets of Rescue Task Force Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) from Galls Uniforms in the amount of \$22,996.65

Whereas, the Mercer County Rapid Response Partnership is comprised of Mercer County Law Enforcement, Fire and EMS agencies that are trained and equipped to respond to an active shooter incident or hostile gathering events within the County. Fire Fighter/EMT's that are trained and equipped, are able to provide immediate lifesaving treatment in unsecured, active shooter and hostile environments. They will remove critically injured persons to a safe and secured treatment area under protection of Police Officers.

Whereas, The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA 3000) is the nationally recognized standard that identifies training and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for Rescue Task Force.


Whereas, PPE includes the following items: Bullet resistant vest, helmet and trauma medical gear. The gear will be assigned to these certified staff members.

Whereas, the Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of said funds in Ordinance 04-215-19-021-052-315 for 5 complete sets of gear in the amount of \$22,996.65

Now Therefore be it Resolved, that the Mayor and Council of Princeton authorizes the purchase of 5 sets of Rescue Task Force Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) from Galls Uniforms in the amount of \$22,996.65.
