



RESOLUTION 21-69

Resolution Authorizing a Supplemental Professional Services Agreement in the Not to Exceed Amount of \$91,144.00 with T&M Associates for Environmental Permitting and Bidding Services (Tasks 1 and 2 and Add Alternate) Related to the Closure of the Princeton Landfill on River Road

WHEREAS, the municipality of Princeton has awarded professional services agreements to T&M Associates for engineering design, plan preparation, and environmental permitting for corrective actions required by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection at the Princeton Sanitary Landfill; and

WHEREAS, at this time the parties also to seek to execute a professional services agreement for purposes of continuing the services from 2020 to 2021 and specifically for purposes of completing revisions to the environmental permit applications for corrective measures, and for bidding services, for the Princeton Sanitary Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the revisions are necessary as a result of the receipt of comments from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and

WHEREAS, T&M Associates has submitted a proposal dated January 26, 2021 to complete the services, a copy of which shall be attached to the Agreement as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Princeton has a need to acquire these services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law” and in connection therewith, T&M Associates has completed and filed with Princeton the required Campaign Contributions Affidavit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.8, Certification Regarding Political Contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26 and affidavit pursuant section 2-87 of the

Princeton Code (collectively, the “Pay-to-Play Forms”); and

WHEREAS, the professional services shall not exceed a total of \$91,144.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services in account 04-215-20-023-089-304; and


WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i), authorizes Princeton to award this agreement as a professional services agreement, without public bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an Agreement with T&M Associates, consistent with the “Whereas” clauses.
2. In addition, the Agreement is hereby awarded without competitive bidding as a professional services agreement as authorized under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i).
3. T&M Associates shall be paid the not to exceed amount of \$91,144.00 for environmental permitting and bidding services. The term of the Agreement shall be one (1) year from execution thereof by the parties.
4. A copy of this Resolution, the Pay-to-Play Forms and the Agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
5. A notice of the award of the Agreement shall be published in the official newspaper as required by law.
