



RESOLUTION 21-70

Resolution Authorizing a License Agreement Between Princeton and Trinity Church for Bank Street Resident and Business Employee Parking for a Term Expiring on July 31, 2021

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Princeton is undertaking the construction of a capital improvement project on Bank Street which will temporarily remove parking and vehicular access to private off-street parking while work is in progress; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department has identified the following three locations for Bank Street residents and employees of 6-10 and 12-14 Nassau Street to park while construction is occurring; on-street metered parking spaces on Paul Robeson Place, on-street metered parking on Mercer Street Extension, and the private parking lot between Mercer Street and Stockton Street (US Route 206) owned by Trinity Church; and

WHEREAS, Trinity Church has previously allowed permit parking for downtown business employees through a now expired license agreement; and

WHEREAS, Trinity Church is willing to allow up to twenty (20) parking spaces be temporarily designated for Bank Street residents and business employees parking subject to the terms, conditions, and rates specified in the attached License Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the License Agreement is estimated to not exceed \$24,640.00, based on the use of twenty parking spaces at a rate of \$224.00 per space per month; and

WHEREAS, the CFO certifies that sufficient funds are available in account 04-215-16-020-076-352; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department recommends the Princeton Mayor and


Council authorize the License Agreement between Princeton and Trinity Church to temporarily provide off-street parking for Bank Street residents and business employees.
