



## **RESOLUTION 21-74**

Resolution Endorsement of the Application of Princeton Environmental Commission and Friends of Princeton Open Space for a \$1500.00 Grant from ANJEC for the Restoration of Riparian Areas Along the Mountain Brook, within the Billy Johnson Mountain Lakes Nature Preserve

WHEREAS, ANJEC, is a non-profit organization that helps New Jersey environmental commissions, individuals, local and state agencies preserve natural resources and promote sustainable communities; and

WHEREAS, ANJEC provides grant funding to environmental commissions to support projects that advance local open space stewardship and help raise the profile of the environmental commissions in the community through publicity and public participation with local groups; and

WHEREAS, the Princeton Environmental Commission requests that the municipality authorize a grant application to ANJEC for the restoration of riparian areas along the Mountain Brook, within the Billy Johnson Mountain Lakes Nature Preserve in the amount of \$1,500; and

WHEREAS, the restoration project will allow for the planting of native plants to replace invasive species.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Mayor and Council have determined that the abovementioned grant is a public benefit and in the best interest of the residents of the Municipality; and

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the Municipality of Princeton, State of New Jersey, authorize the submission of the aforementioned grant from ANJEC to support the Friends of Princeton Open's riparian restoration project and authorize the Municipal Administrator to issue a letter reflecting this endorsement.
