



RESOLUTION 21-86

Resolution Authorizing a Contract with Steven J. Androsko Doing Business as Griggstown Canoe and Kayak Rental in the Amount of \$56,500.00 to Operate the Canoe and Kayak Concession at Turning Basin Park for the 2021 and 2022 Seasons with Provisions for Two Additional One-Year Extensions

WHEREAS, by Resolution #16-63 adopted on February 29, 2016, the Council authorized the advertisement and solicitation of competitive bids for a License to Operate Canoe and Kayak Recreation Services as a concession under the provisions of the New Jersey Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.4; and

WHEREAS, the prior agreement expired in 2020 and therefore, Princeton solicited bids for a new License to Operate Canoe and Kayak Recreation Services as a concession; and

WHEREAS, in response to Princeton's advertisement for said license, on February 25, 2021 Princeton received one (1) bid to operate said concession from Stephen Androsko doing business as (DBA) Griggstown Canoe & Kayak Rental (AKA Griggstown Canoe Rental) of Princeton, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, in reviewing said bid Princeton has determined that the highest responsive and responsible bidder is Stephen Androsko DBA Griggstown Canoe & Kayak Rental (AKA Griggstown Canoe Rental) of Princeton, New Jersey in the bid amount of \$56,500.00 for a two-year term; and

WHEREAS, Princeton wishes to award a contract to operate said concession to the aforementioned highest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, to ensure compliance with the applicable Green Acres Program Rules during the term and execution of said License Agreement, and in particular, N.J.A.C. 7:36-25.13, the License Agreement is subject to the approval of Green Acres.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

1. Subject to the final approval of the License Agreement from Green Acres, as set forth in the "Whereas" clauses above, the Mayor and Clerk of Princeton shall execute said License Agreement with Stephen Androsko DBA Griggstown Canoe & Kayak Rental (AKA Griggstown Canoe Rental), 1076 Canal Road, Princeton, New Jersey 08540, for the purpose of providing for continued operation of canoe and kayak concession services within the Turning Basin Park during the 2021 and 2022 seasons in the amount of \$56,500.00 payable in equal installments per year as follows: \$9,400.00 on June 1, 2021, \$9,400.00 on July 1, 2021, \$9,400.00 on August 1, 2021, \$9,433.33 on June 1, 2022, \$9,433.33 on July 1, 2022, and \$9,433.34 on August 1, 2022, in accordance with the bid dated February 24, 2021. The Municipal Attorney shall be authorized to make any necessary amendments to the License Agreement to ensure compliance with Green Acres Rules.

2. The final License Agreement shall be on file in the office of the Municipal Clerk.
