**Resolution Amending Resolution #21-96 Concerning The Employment of Robert Bruschi as Interim Administrator**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution #21-96 adopted by the Mayor and Council on March 8, 2021, Robert Bruschi was hired as Princeton interim administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution provided for Mr. Bruschi to serve as interim administrator until a successor to outgoing administrator Marc Dashield had been appointed; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution specified that Mr. Bruschi would be expected to work twenty-five weekday daytime hours per week and at other times and to attend meetings as necessary in the performance of his duties; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to increase Mr. Bruschi's weekly daytime hours from twenty-five to thirty-five daytime hours per week; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have chosen Bernard Hvozdovic to be the new municipal administrator and he will begin his service on May 3, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to continue Mr. Bruschi's employment for two to three weeks after the new administrator's start date to assist with a smooth transition; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council therefore wish to amend the terms of Mr. Bruschi's employment with Princeton as interim administrator outlined in Resolution #21-96;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Municipality of Princeton in Mercer County, New Jersey, as follows:

1. Robert Bruschi shall continue to serve as interim administrator for Princeton as set forth

in Resolution #21-96, under the following modified terms and conditions:

- a. Mr. Bruschi shall be expected to work thirty-five weekday daytime hours per week and shall continue to work at other times and attend meetings as necessary in the performance of his duties.
- b. Mr. Bruschi shall remain employed by Princeton for two to three weeks after Mr. Hvozdovic begins working as the municipal administrator to assist with a smooth transition, with the conclusion date of Mr. Bruschi's service to be determined by the new administrator but shall be no later than May 21, 2021.

- c. All other terms and conditions of Resolution #21-96 shall remain in effect.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
