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**RESOLUTION 21-181**

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**Resolution Authorizing the Purchase of GIS Software Licenses from Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. for the Identification, Inspection, and Management of Municipal Sewer and Other Infrastructure at a Not to Exceed Cost of \$17,021.00 using State Contract # M-7003**

**WHEREAS**, sanitary sewers and other capital infrastructure must be inspected, maintained, and periodically repaired and replaced, and Geographic Information System (GIS) software is used to support these functions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Engineering (“Department”) recommends that Princeton procure additional and expanded licensing for Geographic Information System software; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department has researched vendors that would achieve the Department’s goals and determined that the sought-after software may be procured from Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc., 380 New York Street, Redlands California 92373; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3) (as amended by P.L. 2011, c. 139) and Local Finance Notice 2012-10, a New Jersey municipality may purchase goods and services without public bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law through the use of an accepted state contract or a nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding or contracting process by another contracting unit within New Jersey or another State; and

**WHEREAS**, also pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3) (as amended by P.L. 2011, c. 139) and Local Finance Notice 2012-10, prior to making purchases under nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contracts, the municipality must determine that the use of the

cooperative purchasing contract shall result in cost savings after all factors, including charges for service, material, and delivery have been considered; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department has determined that Princeton’s use of the New Jersey State Approved Contract # M-7003 to procure the appropriate GIS software licenses will result in cost savings to Princeton; and

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the New Jersey State approved contract and needs of Princeton, Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. has submitted a quote to provide the GIS software licenses for the sum of \$17,021.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this purchase under the following capital and operating accounts:


