



RESOLUTION 21-281

Resolution Authorizing the Award Services Agreement to General Code, LLC for Code Maintenance Services, Not to Exceed Contract Amount of \$28,500.00

WHEREAS, the municipality of Princeton desires to retain the services of a qualified company for purposes of maintaining the municipal codes on behalf of Princeton, including supplementation of the codes and electronic publishing; and

WHEREAS, General Code, LLC has provided a proposal to Princeton for purposes of performing the sought-after code maintenance services for the not to exceed contract amount of \$28,500.00 and term of Calendar Year 2021; and

WHEREAS, Princeton has a need to acquire these services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law” and in connection therewith, General Code, LLC has completed and filed with Princeton the required Campaign Contributions Affidavit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.8, Certification Regarding Political Contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26 and affidavit pursuant section 2-87 of the Princeton Code (collectively, the “Pay-to-Play Forms”); and

WHEREAS, the agreement shall be for an amount not to exceed \$28,500.00, as more specifically detailed in General Code’s proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services in 01-203-20-120-258 (\$14,000.00), 01-201-20-111-283 (\$14,500.00); and


WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:11-5(1)(x), authorizes Princeton to award an agreement for services in connection with the revision and codification of the municipal ordinances without public bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with General Code, LLC for municipal code maintenance, consistent with this Resolution, General Code’s proposal and the above “Whereas” clauses. The final agreement shall be subject to the approval of the Administrator and Municipal Attorney’s office.
2. The agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as authorized under *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(x)*.
3. General Code, LLC shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$28,500.00. The term of the agreement shall be Calendar Year 2021.
4. A copy of this Resolution, the Pay-to-Play Forms and the agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
