



**RESOLUTION 21-322**

**Resolution Authorizing the Award of a Contract to Suburban Fence Company for the Purchase and Installation of a Perimeter Fence and Gate for the Mercer Street Pump Station which was destroyed by Flood Waters during Super Storm Ida in the amount of \$17,810.00**

WHEREAS, the Department of Sewer Operations (“Department”) recommends that the Municipality of Princeton (“Princeton”) procure a Perimeter Fence and Gate for the Mercer Street Pump Station which was destroyed by flood waters during Super Storm Ida; and

WHEREAS, in response to a solicitation for quotes, Princeton received two (2) quotes, for said purchase; and

WHEREAS, Suburban Fence Company provided the low bid quote to Princeton for purposes of the sought after purchase in the amount of \$17,810.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said purchased in 04-215-19-019-089-302; and


WHEREAS, this contract award is exempt from public bidding pursuant to NJSA 40A:11-3(a) and 40A:11-6.1(a) because the contract amount does not exceed the bid threshold; and

WHEREAS, Princeton wishes to award a contract to undertake and complete said purchase to the aforementioned contractor with the lowest responsible quote.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey that a contract for the purchase of a Perimeter Fence and Gate for the Mercer Street Pump Station which was destroyed by flood waters during Super Storm Ida in the amount of \$17,810.00 is hereby awarded to Suburban Fence Company without public bidding as permitted by law.
