



RESOLUTION 21-327

Resolution Amending 2021 Professional Services Agreement with Lynda Lee for Supplemental Public Health Nursing Services, Increasing 2021 PSA from Not to Exceed Amount of \$20,000 to \$24,000

WHEREAS, Princeton desires to amend existing professional services agreement in connection with certain activities as hereafter more particularly stated, and

WHEREAS, the services to be performed are professional services which are exempt from public bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law, and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services out of the Health Department budget, NJDOH COVID19 Vaccination Supplemental Funding Program line item, Account No. 02-213-44-959-301.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for professional services with **Lynda Lee, 287 Hamilton Ave. Princeton, NJ 08540** (hereinafter referred to as "Provider") to provide consultant services for the Municipality from **January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021**, as hereafter more particularly stated.

1. The contract so authorized shall require the Provider to provide professional health services for a total contract amount not to exceed **\$24,000.00 (increasing \$4,000 from prior not to exceed amount of \$20,000)**.

Under this Agreement, Provider shall at all times act as an independent professional contractor and shall have no authority to act as an agent or representative of Princeton or to enter into any financial or other contractual commitment on behalf of the Princeton without the prior written approval of same granted in accordance with law.

Rendition of Invoices: Payment of fees will be made upon the submission of invoices from the Provider to Princeton in duplicate in the form prescribed by the Princeton not later than the tenth (10th) day of the month following that covered by the invoice, and shall specify in detail the periods for which fees are claimed for the services performed. The provider shall give written notice to Princeton when the Provider has billed eighty (80%) of the compensation set forth in paragraph I of the Agreement.


2. The form of contract shall include standard provisions common to professional service agreements entered into by the Princeton and shall be subject to approval by the Princeton Attorney.

3. The contract shall be awarded without competitive bidding as a contract for professional services under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law because the subject services will be performed by a person or persons authorized by law to practice a recognized profession and whose practice is regulated by law.

4. A notice of this action shall be published in the Princeton Packet as required by law within ten (10) days of its passage.
