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**RESOLUTION 21-332**

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**Resolution Authorizing a Payment in the Amount of \$21,053.00 for Outstanding Traffic Engineering Services Fees to Bright View Engineering, LLC for Preliminary Design of a Traffic Signal Replacement at the Mount Lucas Road / Valley Road / Witherspoon Street Intersection**

**WHEREAS**, the municipality of Princeton retained the services of a professional traffic engineer for the preparation of traffic signal and electrical plans for a replacement signal at the Witherspoon Street / Mount Lucas Road / Valley Road intersection on behalf of Princeton in conjunction with the Princeton First Aid and Rescue Squad site development; and

**WHEREAS**, Bright View Engineering, LLC. had provided a proposal to Princeton dated September 17, 2017 for purposes of performing the sought-after traffic engineering services for a not to exceed contract amount of \$32,320.00 and term of one (1) year; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract has expired on September 25, 2018; and,

**WHEREAS**, remaining open invoices in the amount of \$21,053.00 need to be processed for payment; and,

**WHEREAS**, Princeton had acquired these services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law” and;

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services in capital account 04-215-21-021-076-329; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i), authorizes Princeton to award this agreement as a professional services agreement, without public bidding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The agreement was awarded without competitive bidding as a professional services agreement as authorized under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i).
2. Bright View Engineering, LLC. shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$21,053.00.
4. A copy of this Resolution, the Pay-to-Play Forms and the agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
5. A notice of this action shall be published in the official newspaper as required by law.
