



RESOLUTION 21-346

Resolution for Emergency Repairs to the Asphalt Pathway on Great Road East in the Not to Exceed Amount of \$38,302.50

WHEREAS, by Memorandum dated October 4, 2021, the Princeton Engineer advised the Administrator of the need for Princeton to undertake an emergency repair to the asphalt pathway on Great Road East between Stuart Road and Preserve Drive in Princeton as a result of damage sustained by Tropical Storm Ida on September 1-2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, as detailed in said Memorandum, which is incorporated herein as if fully restated, Princeton solicited a proposal from Black Rock Enterprises, LLC of Old Bridge, New Jersey to complete the emergency repair, which firm is currently under contract with Princeton for two separate projects, specifically one roadway and one pathway project; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2021, Black Rock Enterprises, LLC submitted a proposal in the amount of \$38,302.50 for the requested repair, which included an allowance for uniformed traffic directors; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, and section 2-1.6(o) of the Princeton Code, authorize the Administrator to award a contract exceeding the bid threshold without public bidding therefor when an emergency affecting the public health, safety or welfare requires the immediate performance of services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the LPCL and as authorized by section 2-1.6(o), and based on the Engineer's Memorandum, the Administrator determined that an emergency affecting the public health and safety existed, satisfying the requirements of the LPCL, and necessitating the immediate performance of the work by Black Rock Enterprises, LLC, for the estimated sum of \$38,302.50; and

WHEREAS, Black Rock Enterprises, LLC satisfactorily completed the emergency repairs at a final cost of \$34,462.50, excluding the cost of uniformed traffic directors (the cost of which will be paid to the Mercer County Sheriff's Department directly under separate agreement); and


WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services from 04-215-17-031-089-301.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, the Council hereby ratifies the Administrator's award of the emergency repair agreement to Black Rock Enterprises, LLC based on the reasons set in the "Whereas" clauses and October 4, 2021 Memorandum from the Engineer.
2. Payment in the amount of \$38,302.50 shall be made to Black Rock Enterprises, LLC.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
