



RESOLUTION 21-356

Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Authorizing the Award of a Contract to Generac Power Systems, Inc. via the Sourcewell Contract for the Purchase of One Portable By-Pass Pump and Equipment for Sewer Emergencies in the amount of \$56,685.62

WHEREAS, the Department of Infrastructure and Operations (“Department”) recommends that the Municipality of Princeton (“Princeton”) procure one Portable By-Pass Pump and Equipment for Sewer Emergencies for use by the Sewer Department; and

WHEREAS, the Department has researched vendors that would achieve the Department’s goals and determined that the sought-after Portable By-Pass Pump and Equipment may be procured through a nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract in effect until August 1, 2024 between Sourcewell [formerly known as National Joint Powers Alliance (“NJPA”)] and Generac Power Systems, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Princeton is a member of the Sourcewell (Princeton Member ID # - 28187); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3) (as amended by P.L. 2011, c. 139) and LFN 2012-10, a New Jersey Municipality may purchase goods and services without public bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law through the use of a nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contract that has been developed utilizing a competitive bidding or contracting process by another contracting unit within New Jersey or another State; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell is a regional organization of governmental units operating under the laws of the State of Minnesota and is itself a government corporation and agency pursuant to the laws of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the subject cooperative purchasing contract was awarded by then NJPA to Generac Power Systems, Inc. utilizing a competitive contracting process; and

WHEREAS, also pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2b.(3) (as amended by P.L. 2011, c. 139) and LFN 2012-10, prior to making purchases under nationally-recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing contracts, the Municipality must determine that the use of the cooperative purchasing contract shall result in cost savings after all factors, including charges for service, material, and delivery have been considered; and

WHEREAS, the Department has determined that Princeton’s use of the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing contract to procure the sought-after By-Pass Pump and Equipment; and


WHEREAS, consistent with the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing contract and needs of Princeton, Generac Power Systems, Inc. has submitted a proposal to provide the one Portable By-Pass Pump and Equipment for use by the Sewer Department for the sum of \$56,685.62; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds in the amount of \$56,685.62 in account 04-215-19-019-089-305 are available for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey that a contract for the purchase of one Portable By-Pass Pump and Equipment for use by the Sewer Department in the amount of \$56,685.62 is hereby awarded to Generac Power Systems, Inc. without public bidding as permitted by law.
