



RESOLUTION 21-375

Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Authorizing the Purchase of Community Park Pool Filter Replacement Parts from If It's Water, Inc. in the Amount of \$31,591.44

WHEREAS, the Community Park Pool Nemato Filters sustained significant damage as a result of Tropical Storm Ida on 9/1/21; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Department must replace many of the internal components to those filters in order to successfully operate the pool; and

WHEREAS, If It's Water, Inc. is the authorized regional dealer for Nemato Filter parts and the equipment is proprietary; and

WHEREAS, the cost for those replacement part plus shipping is \$31,591.44

WHEREAS, the appropriate monies are provided in Account # 01-201-28-375-246; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said purchases; and

WHEREAS, the municipality expects to receive reimbursement funds from FEMA for damages to municipal property sustained as a result of Tropical Storm Ida.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of Princeton authorize the Administrator and staff to purchase the above described equipment for use by the Recreation Department in the total amount of \$31,591.44
