



RESOLUTION 22-20

Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Approving the
Parking Utility Operating Temporary Budget for 2022

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-19 provides that where any contract, commitment or payments are
to be made prior to the final adoption of the 2022 budget, temporary appropriations should be
made for the purpose and amounts required in the manner and time therein provided: and

WHEREAS, the date as this resolution is within the first thirty days of January 2022 and;

WHEREAS, the total appropriations in the 2022 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made
for interest and debt redemption charges, is the sum of \$490,000.00

WHEREAS, twenty-six and one quarter percent of the total appropriations in the 2021 budget,
exclusive of any appropriations made for interest and debt redemption charges in said 2021
budget is the sum of \$681,063.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following appropriations be made
