



RESOLUTION 22-30

Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Authorizing Tax Sale

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:5-19 sets forth the requirement for the tax collector to hold a tax sale for unpaid taxes; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 99, P.L. of 1997, has amended the Tax Sale law; and,

WHEREAS, there exist certain ambiguities in the language of said amendments,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to hold a tax sale in 2022 to include unpaid taxes or other municipal liens or charges for the years 2021 or prior.
