RESOLUTION 22-50

Resolution Awarding a Contract to Precision Technology Solutions for Upgrades to Parking Equipment Upgrades at the Spring Street Garage in the Not to Exceed Amount of \$32,010.00

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Princeton (“Princeton”) desires to procure goods and services necessary to complete upgrades to the certain equipment at the Spring Street Garage; and

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2022, Precision Technology Solutions submitted to Princeton a proposal to provide the sought-after equipment and render services including installation of said equipment for a not to exceed cost of \$32,010.00; and

WHEREAS, additional proposals were not solicited because it was not practicable to do so; and

WHEREAS, Princeton has a need to acquire these goods and services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law,” and in connection therewith, Precision Technology Solutions has completed and filed with Princeton the required Campaign Contributions Affidavit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.8 and Certification Regarding Political Contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26; and

WHEREAS, Princeton seeks to award the agreement to Precision Technology Solutions based on price and other factors; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services from account 06-215-18-009-301; and


WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a. authorizes Princeton to award this agreement without public bidding because it will not exceed the bid threshold.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Precision Technology Solutions of Ambler, Pennsylvania, to provide the goods and services necessary to complete upgrades to certain equipment at the Spring Street Garage, consistent with this Resolution and the above "Whereas" clauses.
2. The agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a.
3. Precision Technology Solutions shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$32,010.00.
4. A copy of this Resolution and the agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
