



RESOLUTION 22-97

Resolution Approving an Emergency Temporary Appropriation for the 2022 Affordable Housing Utility Fund Budget

WHEREAS, an emergent 2022 condition has arisen with respect to the 2022 Affordable Housing Utility Fund Budget, due to the lack of an adopted 2022 Affordable Housing Utility Fund Budget and no adequate provision has been made in the 2022 temporary budget for appropriations for the next several months, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency temporary appropriation for the purpose above mentioned, and

WHEREAS, the total emergency temporary resolutions adopted in the year 2022 pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 96, P.L. 1951 (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20) including the original 2022 temporary budget and this resolution total \$278,000

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20:

- 1. An emergency temporary appropriation be and the same is hereby made as follows in the amount of \$130,000

Affordable Housing Utility - Salary & Wages \$ 28,000
Affordable Housing Utility - Other Expenses \$102,000

- 2. That the emergency temporary appropriation has been provided for in the 2022 Budget under the said title.

That one certified copy of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
