



RESOLUTION 22-124

Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Extending Contract Term for Agreement with Princeton Senior Resource Center for Provision of Programming and Services to Senior Citizens in the Community in the Amount of \$159,008.00

WHEREAS, on or about June 14, 2021, Princeton Council awarded a contract to Princeton Senior Resource Center to provide programs and services to aging adults at the Suzanne Patterson Center, Spruce Center, 101 Poor Farm Road and various outreach locations for an initial term of one year and contract amount of \$155,359.00 (to be paid in 12 equal monthly installments) (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that the parties may extend the contract for up to two additional one-year terms, and the parties seek to extend it for the first such extension, from January 1, 2022 until December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Princeton Senior Resource Center has offered to continue to provide the services under the Agreement for \$159,008.00, which is a \$3,659.00 increase (2.35%) over the 2021 fees, which is less than the change in the index rate for the 12 months preceding the most recent quarterly calculation available at this time; and

WHEREAS, Princeton Senior Resource Center has been performing the services under the Agreement in an effective and efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this contract extension in 01-201-27-331-299.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Princeton Council on this 28th day of March, 2022 that:

1. The Agreement with Princeton Senior Resource Center for the provision of programming and services to aging adults in the community is hereby extended from January 1, 2022 until December 31, 2022.
2. The total contract amount for the term of the extension shall be \$159,008.00 for 2022 services, to be paid in 12 monthly installments.
3. All remaining provisions of the Agreement not inconsistent herewith shall remain the same.
4. This contract extension is awarded pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15 because Princeton Senior Resource Center has performed the services in an effective and efficient manner.
5. This Resolution, when countersigned by Princeton Senior Resource Center, shall serve as an amendment to the original Agreement for the purpose of confirming the extension of the contract term until December 31, 2022 and not-to-exceed contract price of \$159,008.00 for the extended period.
6. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed on file in the Office of the Township Clerk.


