



RESOLUTION 22-127

Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Authorizing the Purchase of Personal Protective Equipment to Improve COVID-19 Preparedness in Princeton's Vulnerable Population, Not to Exceed \$29,980.86

WHEREAS, Princeton is in need of public health preparedness supplies for Princeton residents disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, Princeton wishes to purchase personal protective equipment and other COVID-19 quarantine/isolation products through NJ State Contract WB Mason State Contract No. G0002 and;

WHEREAS, the personal protective equipment and other quarantine/isolation supplies will provide residents with basic items they may need if they are exposed to COVID-19 or contract COVID-19 and;

WHEREAS, the personal protective equipment and other quarantine/isolation supplies being purchased are based upon recommendations by the Centers for Disease Control and;

WHEREAS, the personal protective equipment and other quarantine/isolation supplies will be purchased with community development block grant (CBDG) funding and;

WHEREAS, the total cost of PPE and COVID-19 recovery supplies will total \$29,930.86;

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services out of the line item, Account No. 01-201-27-330-281.
