Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Authorizing Use of the Funds Approved in the Capital Budget for Installation of Air Conditioning at the Police Training Center for the Amount of \$13,500.00

WHEREAS, the Princeton Police Department respectfully requests \$13, 500.00 for the installation of air conditioning in the Police Training Center, 27 N. Harrison St. Princeton NJ.

WHEREAS, the council previously approved \$22,000.00 for this project in the Capital Budget.

WHEREAS, three quotes were recently obtained and \$13,500.00 was the lowest of three estimates.

WHEREAS, installation of air conditioning would allow the training center, which includes our virtual reality simulator, to be utilized over the course of the entire year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Mayor & Council of Princeton that it does hereby accept the cost in the amount of \$13,500.00 for air condition and related equipment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor & Council of Princeton, New Jersey authorize the Administrator to accept and execute the resolution for the purpose described in the application.
