



**RESOLUTION 22-174**

**Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Authorizing a Contract Award to National Water Main Cleaning in the Amount of \$16,500.00 for the Purpose of Performing Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Inspections of Sanitary Sewer Laterals Located in the Witherspoon Phase 2 and Phase 3 Project Areas (Green Street to Valley Road)**

**WHEREAS**, Princeton has a need to hire a qualified contractor to inspect the sanitary sewer laterals on Witherspoon Street between the intersections with Green Street and Valley Road using a lateral launching closed circuit television (CCTV) unit; and

**WHEREAS**, Princeton solicited proposals from at least two vendors, and in response thereto, received a proposal dated February 25, 2022 from National Water Main Cleaning Company to provide the sought-after services for a fee of \$16,5000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sewer Engineer recommends that an award be made to National Water Main Cleaning Company; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services from account 04-215-17-031-089-309; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a. and 40A:11-6.1a., authorizes Princeton to award this agreement without public bidding because it will not exceed the applicable bid threshold.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by Princeton Mayor and Council, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:


1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement

with National Water Main Cleaning Company for purposes of inspecting the sanitary sewer laterals on Witherspoon Street between the intersections with Green Street and Valley Road using a lateral launching CCTV unit consistent with this Resolution and the above “Whereas” clauses.

2. The agreement is awarded without competitive bidding because it will not exceed the applicable bid threshold as authorized under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a. and 40A:11-6.1a
3. The work shall be completed in accordance with the schedule set forth in the Agreement.
4. The Sewer Engineer and Municipal Attorney are authorized to make clarifications and non-substantial changes to the terms of the Agreement prior to execution.
5. A copy of this Resolution, the local Pay-to-Play Form, and the agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
