Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Authorizing the Donation of Excess Fire Equipment to Princeton Plasma Physics Laboratory

WHEREAS, The Princeton Department of Emergency and Safety Services identifies equipment at the Princeton Fire Department that is outdated or not used and;

WHEREAS, The Princeton Plasma Physics Laboratory Fire Department asked if any excess equipment could be identified to equip a used fire engine they were receiving, and adding to their Fire Department, which was being received with no equipment and;

WHEREAS, The Princeton Plasma Physics Laboratory Fire Department responds automatically into Princeton, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, to provide staffing and fire suppression resources, and;

WHEREAS, The equipment listed below is not currently being used on apparatus and is nearing its service life or deemed excess in the Princeton Fire Department.

- 200' White 2 1/2 Hose

- 1 pick head axe
- 1 - 4" x 5" storz adapter
- 1 - 2.5' Female NST x 1 3/4 wye
- 2 - 2.5' Dounble Female adapter
- 2 - 2.5" Double Male adapter
- 1 - Steamer NST x 5" storz adapter
- 1 - steamer intake valve
