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**RESOLUTION 22-184**

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**Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Authorizing a Professional Services Agreement with Johnson, Mirmiran, & Thompson, Inc. for Professional Engineering Consulting Services for the Purpose of Providing Capital Infrastructure Construction Administration and Inspections for Capital Projects for 2022-23 in an Amount Not to Exceed \$30,000.00**

WHEREAS, the municipality of Princeton desires to retain the services of a qualified Professional Engineering consultant for the purposes of supplementing staff in providing capital infrastructure construction administration and inspections for capital projects undertaken by the municipality and for purposes of providing these necessary support services on an as needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the municipality of Princeton has requested proposals from Professional Engineering consultants and has evaluated those proposals to determine the most qualified to provide these services, and

WHEREAS, Johnson, Mirmiran & Thompson, Inc. ("JMT") has provided a proposal and 2022 Fee Schedule to Princeton for purposes of performing the sought-after capital infrastructure construction administration and inspections services; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department has estimated, based upon past capital infrastructure construction administration and inspection contracts, that the professional services contract amount shall not exceed \$30,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Princeton has a need to acquire these services without a "fair and open process" as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the "Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law" and in connection therewith, JMT will complete and file with Princeton the required Campaign Contributions Affidavit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.8, Certification Regarding Political Contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26 and affidavit pursuant section 2-87 of the Princeton Code (collectively, the "Pay-to-Play Forms"); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available in the appropriate capital improvement account 04-215-21-021-076-333 to pay for said services; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i), authorizes Princeton to award this agreement as a professional services agreement, without public bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Princeton Mayor and Council, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with JMT for professional engineering consulting services, consistent with this Resolution and the above "Whereas" clauses.
2. The agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as a professional services agreement as authorized under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i).

3. Consultant fees shall be paid in accordance with the 2022 JMT's Fee Schedule for the work hours completed. The professional services agreement amount shall not exceed \$30,000.00. The term of the agreement shall be one year commencing on June 1, 2022.
4. A copy of this Resolution, the Pay-to-Play Forms and the agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
5. A notice of this action shall be published in the official newspaper as required by law.
