



RESOLUTION 22-190

Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Support for Mercer County's Proposed Construction Staging Plan on Rosedale Road (County Route 604) to Accommodate Construction of a Roundabout at the Intersection with General Johnson Road and Greenway Meadows Park in Summer 2022

WHEREAS, Rosedale Road is under the jurisdiction of Mercer County and is designated County Route 604; and

WHEREAS, Princeton and Mercer County have adopted Complete Street Policies, which contribute to safety by requiring improvements to support all road users including pedestrians and bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, Princeton received a federal Safe Routes to School grant to make improvements to Rosedale Road for safer student bicycling and walking access to Johnson Park Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, Mercer County has proposed the installation of a roundabout at the intersection of Rosedale Road and General Johnson Road to calm vehicular traffic in this corridor and to complement Princeton's Safe Route to School project; and

WHEREAS, Mercer County proposes to construct the roundabout while the Princeton Public Schools are not in session, beginning on or about June 21, 2022 with a completion date before September 6, 2022 ; and

WHEREAS, Mercer County proposes to construct the roundabout in two stages by closing the roadway to through traffic at General Johnson Road, and establishing local access to Johnson Park Elementary School and Greenway Meadows as follows and as shown in the attached plans:

- Stage 1 - All vehicles shall access Johnson Park Elementary School and Greenway Meadows Park via eastbound travel on Rosedale Road (County Route 604) from the direction of Province Line Road; and
- Stage 2- All vehicles shall access Johnson Park Elementary School and Greenway Meadows Park via westbound travel on Rosedale Road (County Route 604) from the direction of Elm Road (County Route 604).

WHEREAS, the municipal staff in the Departments of Engineering, Recreation, and Police have no objection to the proposed traffic control plan to close Rosedale Road (County Route 604) to through traffic at the General Johnson Road / Greenway Meadows Park intersection for the anticipated two-month duration of the roundabout construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Municipality of Princeton that the Municipality of Princeton hereby endorses the proposed traffic control plan to close Rosedale Road (County Route 604) to through traffic at the General Johnson Road / Greenway Meadows Park intersection for the anticipated two-month duration of the roundabout construction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be sent to the Mercer County Board of County Commissioners for action.
