



RESOLUTION 22-209

Resolution of the Mayor and Council of Princeton Approving the Placement Pole Banners on Nassau Street by the Princeton University Art Museum, June 18, 2022 to June 12, 2023

WHEREAS, The Princeton University Art Museum is planning exhibitions that will highlight works across the Art Museum's curatorial areas, from diverse cultures around the world; and

WHEREAS, The Princeton University Art Museum has requested permission to install eight pole banners on Nassau Street with the approval of the Office of Community and State Affairs at Princeton University beginning Saturday, June 18, 2022 through Tuesday, June 12, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the pole banners will be promptly removed after use as required by Princeton ordinances; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Princeton Ordinance 14-32 any banner that is removed by Princeton will be held by Princeton for thirty (30) days and then disposed of; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Princeton Ordinance 14-32 any applicant failing to remove a banner will not be permitted to display any banner for the succeeding two years; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council hereby approve placement of said pole banners on Nassau Street in accordance with Princeton Ordinances 14-28 to 14-32.
