Resolution for the Establishment of a Transportation Communication Task Force

WHEREAS, the municipality of Princeton seeks to promote current and future non-single occupant car transportation in Princeton; and

WHEREAS, Princeton has underused public transit options, biking and walking routes, while also struggling with serious traffic congestion and limited parking; and

WHEREAS, Princeton wants to effectively encourage people who currently drive alone to regularly use other options so as to improve the quality of life in the municipality; and

WHEREAS, non-single-occupant car options can result in better health for residents, lessened traffic, lower environmental pollution, and even lower costs to residents and the town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. A Transportation Communications Task Force will be established to communicate and promote options for public transit, walking, biking, ride-sharing and parking

3. The Task Force will develop communication materials with the approval of Princeton administration to educate and inform the public about transportation options.
