RESOLUTION 19-74

Resolution Awarding a Portion of the Contract Known as "Road Materials" to Trap Rock Industries, LLC in the amount of \$39,525.00

WHEREAS, the Department of Infrastructure and Operations has advised the Mayor and Council of the need for the purchase of road materials for use on various projects; and

WHEREAS, a contract known as "Road Materials" for said purchase was put out to public bid, the bids being received and opened on February 5, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Princeton received the following bids in connection with said contract:

American Asphalt Company, Inc., Collingswood Heights, New Jersey, and

Trap Rock Industries, LLC, Kingston, New Jersey.

WHEREAS, the staff has reviewed the bids and determined that the bid submitted by Trap Rock Industries, LLC, Kingston, N.J. is a responsible bid for this project for the following categories:

Category B - Bituminous Materials - Delivered in the amount of \$17,500.00.

Category C - Bituminous Cold Weather Hot Patch Materials - FOB in the amount of \$10,700.00,

Category D - Clean Stone - FOB in the amount of \$5,037.50,

Category F - Quarry Blend - FOB in the amount of \$6,287.50; and

WHEREAS, Princeton's Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available up to a maximum contract value of \$39,525.00 for these road materials as follows:

- Capital Account 04-215-14-025-089-343 (Ordinance 2014-25 Various Improvements, Sanitary Sewer System Repairs, Balance of \$65,000.00) in the amount of \$20,000.00; and
- Capital Account 04-215-17-037-011-302 (Ordinance 2017-37 Various Capital Improvements, John Street Facility, Balance of \$642,700.00) in the amount of \$19,525.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

- 1. That a portion of the contract known as "Road Materials" is awarded to Trap Rock Industries, Kingston, N.J. in the bid amount of \$39,525.00.
- The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a contract with Trap Rock Industries, LLC.
- 3. A copy of this Resolution, the Pay-to-Play Forms and the Agreement shall be placed on file in the Offices of the Clerk.
