



RESOLUTION 19-77

Resolution Amending the Paving Design & Materials in the Adopted Nassau Streetscape Design Standards, Dated Fall 2016, to Specify Bluestone-Colored (Tinted) Concrete in a Rectangular – Perpendicular Design

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of Princeton adopted the Nassau Streetscape Design Standards (Standards), prepared by Looney Ricks Kiss (LRK), on January 23, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Standards incorporated concrete London Pavers and shale / clay brick-sized pavers as the required Paving Design & Materials; and

WHEREAS, the Princeton Historic Preservation Commission recommended the use of only concrete London Pavers laid in a running bond; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department has been advised by the New Jersey Department of Transportation that concrete pavers are not a standard sidewalk material; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation is the owner of the Nassau Street (NJ 27) right of way and, thus, has jurisdiction over materials to be used on their property; and


WHEREAS, the Princeton Engineering Department seeks the following amendment to the Standards for an alternative Paving Design and Materials, as more fully described and justified in a Memorandum updated on February 20, 2019:

1. Bluestone-colored (tinted) concrete in lieu of London Pavers and brick pavers.
2. Rectangular - perpendicular paving design.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that the Paving Design & Materials of the Standards shall be amended to incorporate bluestone-colored tinted concrete with a rectangular - perpendicular design, as illustrated in the Memorandum updated on February 20, 2019 from Deanna Stockton, P.E., C.M.E. to Marc D. Dashield.
