



RESOLUTION 19-149

Resolution Authorizing Sixteen Hour Work Days and a Full Roadway Closure for a Maximum of One Hundred Thirty-Five Days, and Nighttime Work Hours from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. to Replace Mercer County Bridge Structures #330.1 and #331.1 on Alexander Street Beginning in November 2019

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Princeton has jurisdiction of Alexander Street within the Municipality of Princeton; and

WHEREAS, Mercer County has jurisdiction of Bridges #330.1 (Structure #1100-065) and #331.1 (Structure #11C3101), which carry Alexander Street over Stony Brook and a tributary to Stony Brook, respectively; and

WHEREAS, Mercer County has determined that the referenced structures on Alexander Street are in a deteriorated condition and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, Mercer County is currently bidding the construction of the replacement structures with a bid opening date of June 4, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Mercer County has determined that the most expeditious way to complete the construction project is to work double shifts for a period not to exceed one hundred and thirty-five days; and

WHEREAS, Alexander Street may not be closed prior to November 6, 2019 ; and


WHEREAS, Mercer County requests that Princeton endorse the extended work hours until 11:00 pm Monday through Saturday to accommodate the one hundred and thirty-five day construction period and roadway closure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton that Mercer County is approved by Princeton Council to engage in construction work during the night

time hours of 6:00 pm to 11:00 pm, Monday through Saturday beginning on or after November 6, 2019 until Alexander Street is reopened.
