



RESOLUTION 19-125

Resolution Authorizing the Encumbrance of \$7,500.00 for the Purchase of Bicycle Parking Equipment from Ben Shaffer Recreation, Inc. Under State Contract No. 16-FLEET-00135 (T No. T0103)

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Princeton purchased bicycle parking equipment in 2018 to establish its first bicycle corral on Witherspoon Street north of Hulfish Street and opposite Princeton Public Library; and

WHEREAS, this bicycle corral was very well used; and

WHEREAS, Municipality of Princeton seeks to purchase additional bicycle parking equipment to create new bicycle corrals on additional municipal roadways in the central business district, and to test out retrofitting of parking meter poles for bicycle parking; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12 provides that a contracting unit may, without advertising for bids, purchase any materials, supplies or equipment under any contract entered into on behalf of the State Department of Treasury Division of Purchase and Property; and,

WHEREAS, Ben Shaffer Recreation, Inc., P.O. Box 844 Lake Hopatcong, New Jersey 07849, has been awarded the New Jersey State Contract #16-FLEET-00135 (T No.: T0103) for park and playground equipment; and

WHEREAS, there are appropriate monies available in capital account 04-215-17-037-076-324 as certified by the Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department currently seeks to purchase said bicycle parking equipment in the amount of approximately \$4,500.00, with provision to purchase

additional bicycle parking equipment up to \$7,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to encumber up to \$7,500.00 for the purchase of bicycle parking related items from the above vendor under the State Contract noted above.
- These expenditures shall be charged to the appropriate capital account.
