



RESOLUTION 19-134

Resolution Authorizing the Donation of Recovered Bicycles

WHEREAS, The Princeton Police Department regularly recovers abandoned bicycles that are not claimed, and;

WHEREAS, These bicycles are retained by the police department for a period of at least six months per N.J.S.A. 40A:14-157 and subsequently sent to auction or destroyed, and;

WHEREAS, Princeton would like to donate bicycles to individuals and families in need as well as non-profit organizations that can donate them, and;

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-157 permits the donations of recovered property through formal governing body authorization that is not claimed by a rightful owner for a period of six months;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Princeton that Princeton is authorized to donate recovered bicycles to individuals and families in need as well as through non-profit organizations and such transfers of property shall be authorized by the Chief of Police or his designee through the policies regarding the proper and authorized disposal of property and evidence retained by the police department.
