



RESOLUTION 19-142

Resolution Approving the Placement Pole Banners on Nassau Street
by the Princeton University Art Museum
Monday, June 24, 2019 to Monday, October 21, 2019

WHEREAS, The Princeton University Art Museum to promote the upcoming art museum exhibit: Helen Frankenthaler Prints: Seven Types of Ambiguity; and

WHEREAS, The Arts Council of Princeton has requested permission to install eight pole banners on Nassau Street with the approval of the Office of Community and State Affairs at Princeton University beginning Monday, June 24, 2019, through Monday, October 21, 2019 to advertise the upcoming art museum exhibit; and

WHEREAS, the pole banners will be promptly removed after use as required by Borough ordinances; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Borough Ordinance 3-17 any banner that is removed by Princeton will be held by Princeton for thirty (30) days and then disposed of; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Borough Ordinance 3-17 any applicant failing to remove a banner will not be permitted to display any banner for the succeeding two years; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council hereby approve placement of said pole banners on Nassau Street in accordance with Borough Ordinances 3-14-3-17.
