RESOLUTION

**ADOPTION OF GUIDELINES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SOLAR PANELS IN
PRINCETON HISTORIC DISTRICTS**

WHEREAS, the Princeton Historic Preservation Commission (“HPC”) is called upon to consider granting Historic Preservation Plan approval or the submittal of comments and recommendations to the Princeton Planning Board and the Princeton Zoning Board of Adjustment pursuant to Section 10B-379(2) of the Princeton Code when solar panels are proposed to be installed upon a structure located in one of the Princeton Historic Districts; and

WHEREAS, HPC has reviewed the Secretary of Interiors recommended goals for the installation of solar panels on structures located within historic districts; and

WHEREAS, HPC wishes to provide guidance to applicants to HPC or the above-referenced Princeton Land Use Boards concerning HPC’s evaluation of request for the installation of solar panels upon structures located within Princeton Historic Districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that HPC hereby adopts the attached guidelines for the installation of solar panels in Princeton Historic Districts.
