The following is a partial list of native trees in the region recommended to be used on projects in the Princeton area. All are readily available nursery stock.

Evergreen Trees

Notes

Only 50% of the total number of trees selected for a replanting plan can be chosen from the Ornamental and Evergreen categories unless approved by the Municipal Arborist.

Thuja occidentalis, American Arborvitae, is to be used sparingly for credit in a replanting plan and must be approved by the Municipal Arborist.

If a desired species is not on this list, please seek approval from the Municipal Arborist before selecting it.
