IMPROVEMENTS TO LINDEN LANE AND SPRUCE STREET Project Update Notice No. 5 November 6, 2019

Dear Linden Lane and Spruce Street Neighborhood Property Owners and Residents:

Starting November 12, 2019 and continuing throughout the remainder of the month, the municipality's contractor, Integrated Construction & Utilities of New Jersey LLC (ICUNJ), will be delivering more equipment and materials to begin repairing/replacing sanitary sewer laterals for homes on Spruce Street between Moore Street and Moran Avenue as well as the sanitary main in the road. It is anticipated that work will progress east on a block-by-block basis until reaching Spruce Street Circle.

The first area of work will be begin on Spruce Street **between Moore Street and Moran Avenue** on both sides of the road. **Spruce Street will be closed to all traffic Tuesday-Friday, 7:00am-6:00pm. On-street parking in the work area will be prohibited while work is taking place.** Extensive planning efforts have been made to minimize disruption during construction. Residents can park on Moran Avenue or on Spruce Street going east towards Pine Street. The road will reopen at the end of each work day.

If Princeton residents need to park overnight on the street, a temporary parking placard can be issued. Please contact Tiffany Smith, tsmith@princetonnj.gov to obtain a placard. Vehicle information will be given to parking enforcement and police to prevent tickets being issued.

The following is expected to occur:

- ICUNJ will repair/replace individual sewer laterals and main in the roadway, concurrently.
- Each lateral will be disconnected for a period of time while the existing lateral is being repaired/replaced. Notices will be left on doors to homes anticipated being worked on the following day.
- ICUNJ will install a cleanout outside your home/structure as well as at the ROW line. It is recommended that the homeowner or representative be present or available during lateral repair/replacement.
- This work is expected to continue throughout November.

Despite our best efforts to notify service providers, we advise that there will most likely be disruptions to garbage collection and recycling when work is taking place. Please report a missed trash pickup via SeeClickFix, or report a missed recycling pickup to Mercer County Improvement Authority (contact information for both on page 3). In cases of an emergency, the contractor can accommodate all emergency vehicles into a work zone. Access for services and deliveries within

the construction limits shall be maintained at all times during construction. If special accommodations are required, please advise us at the earliest convenience.

Ian Baker, Construction Engineer, is the main point of contact. Ian Baker and Tiffany Smith, Inspector, will be on-site daily while the contractor is working to observe the work. A project contact list is provided on the next page of this notice.
